Luke 18:1-8 (NIV) <sup>1</sup> Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up. <sup>2</sup> He said: "In a certain town there was a judge who neither feared God nor cared about men. <sup>3</sup> And there was a widow in that town who kept coming to him with the plea, 'Grant me justice against my adversary.' <sup>4</sup> "For some time he refused. But finally he said to himself, 'Even though I don't fear God or care about men, <sup>5</sup> yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will see that she gets justice, so that she won't eventually wear me out with her coming!" <sup>6</sup> And the Lord said, "Listen to what the unjust judge says. <sup>7</sup> And will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him day and night? Will he keep putting them off? <sup>8</sup> I tell you, he will see that they get justice, and quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth?"

### There are a lot of faulty misconceptions about prayer

#### Jesus told us to pray...

Luke 18:1 (NIV) Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up.

#### Pray about everything...

Philippians 4:6 (NLT) Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything...

Jesus said,

Matthew 11:28-30 (NIV) <sup>28</sup> "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup> For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

Col 4:2 (NIV) <sup>2</sup> Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.



vv 2-5 <sup>2</sup> He said: "In a certain town there was a judge who neither feared God nor cared about men. <sup>3</sup> And there was a widow in that town who kept coming to him with the plea, <u>'Grant me</u> justice against my adversary.' <sup>4</sup> "For some time he refused. #### Elijah...

Jam 5:17 (NIV) <sup>17</sup> Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed <u>earnestly</u> that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years.

Jam 5:16 (NKJV) <sup>16</sup> ... The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

#### Psalmist said...

Ps 119:145 (NIV) <sup>145</sup> I call with all my heart; answer me...

#### But many of God's people fail to do this!

Hos 7:14 (NIV) <sup>14</sup> They do not cry out to me from their hearts but wail upon their beds. They gather together for grain and new wine but turn away from me.

Phlp 4:6 (NIV) <sup>6</sup> Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, <u>present your requests</u> to God.

**Quote:** Prayer is not overcoming God's reluctance; prayer is laying hold of God's willingness.

## 3. Don't mistake \_\_\_\_\_ with \_\_\_\_\_.

vv 6-8 <sup>6</sup> And the Lord said, "Listen to what the unjust judge says. <sup>7</sup> And will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him day and night? Will he keep putting them off? <sup>8</sup> I tell you, he will see that they get justice, and quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth?"

#### A delayed answer teaches perseverance and builds strength.

Jam 1:2-4 (NIV) <sup>2</sup> Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, <sup>3</sup> because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. <sup>4</sup> Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
